AVATAR ADI DA SAMRAJ: All "objects" Evoke Wanting Need (Anticipating Gain). Wanting Need Provokes Seeking. Seeking Becomes Aggressive Anger, Failing Even Before It Fails.

And Anger Is self-Inflicted Pain. Be Always (Rightly, Truly, and Fully) Devoted To Me, and (Thereby) Observe, and Understand:

All "others" Evoke Seeking-Desire (Always Anticipating Eventual Release From Seeking-Desire Itself).

Seeking-Desire Always Provokes Both Attachment and Avoidance, Simultaneously.

Attachment and Avoidance Become Sorrow, Inevitably.

And Sorrow Is The Illusion Of Emptiness.

Be Always (Rightly, Truly, and Fully) Devoted To Me, and (Thereby) Observe, and Understand:

All "things" Evoke Wonder (How Being Seems A Pair With changes).

Wonder Provokes Bewilderment, and Also knowledge.

Bewilderment and knowledge Always Seek To Become Separated From Fear.

And Fear Itself Is The Visionary Mood Of Separateness.

Separateness, Emptiness, and Pain Are The Constant Complaint, The Un-Breakable Habit, and The Inevitable Destiny Of the body-mind.

Therefore, whatever conditionally arises Also Afflicts.

To Truly "Radically" Understand Is To

Stop Resisting This Understanding.

No "object" Is Worthy Of Wanting Need.

No Search Is Fruitful.

No Pain Is Necessary.

No "other" Is Worthy Of Futile Seeking-Desire and Inevitable Emptiness.

Neither Attachment Nor Avoidance Is Right.

No Sorrow Is Necessary.

No "thing" Is More Than Wonderful. Neither Bewilderment Nor knowledge

Fear Itself Is Ultimate Pain, but It Is Utterly Un-Necessary.

Seeking and Attaining Are (Inevitably) A Total Loss, and Loss Itself Is The Only Constant Discovery In Every Gain.

Seeking By Desiring Is (Itself), Even Previous To Either Gain Or Loss, An **Empty Hole Of Unending Darkness** (self-Contracted From The One and Only "All" Of The Unbroken and Indivisible Divine Conscious Light), but Seeking-Desire Is An Illusion Of Filling (and Only A Search For Possible Fullness), Because It Is "Filled" Only With mind-and mind Cannot Be Truly Filled, Because it Is Always "Full" Of itself (and The Self-Evidently Divine Fullness That Truly, and Even Always Already, Fills all-and-All Is "Outside", or Perfectly Beyond, The Presumed "Center" and The Presumed "Bounds" Of every one and every "thing").

The knowledge Of Bewilderment (and Not any Filling-"object" or Filling-"other") Is the Only "thing" in mind.

The world of "objects", or "others", or "things" Already (In any moment) Bites - and it Always Bites Back.

Therefore, Listen To Me (Perfectly), and Hear Me (Perfectly), and See Me (Perfectly), and Stand Back In Me (The Only One "Who" Is), and Feel Me (The Only "What" and "Where" Of Is).

To Seek "objects" (and Not To Understand That All Seeking Is Moved By Pain) Is Pain Itself, and Bewilderment.

To Desire "others" or To Avoid them

(and Not To Understand That Desire and Avoidance Are Made Of Sorrow) Is Sorrow Itself, and Dark Emptiness.

To Wonder and To know "things" (and Not To Understand That knowledge Is Never Satisfied) Is The Essence Of Fear

The "personal identity", the ego-"I", or the Separate, Darkly Empty, Painful, and psycho-physically self-Contracted body-mind Is Always An Illusion, An Un-Recognized Reflection Of Consciousness (or Mere Tacit Awareness) Itself-A Mirage Of Need, Searchfull Desirability, and Wonder, Superimposed On Consciousness (or Mere Tacit Awareness) Itself By The Apparent (and Un-Necessary) Flow Of Events That (In Themselves) Are (It Seems) Not Consciousness (or Mere Tacit Awareness) Itself.

There <u>Is</u> Not (Now, or Ever) any "personal identity" (or Separate entity of ego-"I"), but Always Only The Ultimate (and Self-Evidently Divine) Identity, or Non-Separate (and Inherently egoless) Conscious Light Itself-Always Already Free, One, Indivisible, Whole, Full, and All-Love-Bliss-"Bright".

Therefore, By Growing In (and Only By Means Of) ego-Transcending

Devotion To Me, Grow To Perfectly Observe and Perfectly Understand and (Thus) Perfectly Transcend and Perfectly Forget The conditionally arising Illusion Of Separateness and Relatedness.


Stand Free, and Be (What Is, and what conditionally arises)-but Do Not Look (or Become "Other" Than what conditionally

A Builder's Blog



It was with a great deal of anticipation and some anxiety that I set off for five weeks service retreat at Avatar Adi Da's

Hermitage Ashram on the island of Naitauba in Fiji. Although I have been a devotee of Adi Da for many years I had not yet had the opportunity to be in His physical company. Because I am a building contractor I was going to help with the final stage of a new temple that was being constructed on the Island. The intensity of the preparation in the weeks prior to leaving, missing a plane on the way and intense seasickness on a 5 hour boat trip ensured that I arrived in a humbled disposition.

I was Blessed to see Adi Da the very next day and, because the temple was being constructed next to His residence, I had the

opportunity to every day over the weeks that followed. What became immediately clear however was my lack of preparedness to receive what He has to Give. Instead of being able to be relaxed and contemplative in His Company and receive His Blessing, I found that my mind was very active and my emotions agitated. I had often heard about this from other devotees who had been in Adi Da's Company, but it was still a shock to experience it myself. Being in His Company can be an intense process of having your state magnified and reflected back to you. I had strong feelings of being "not good enough" and I thus became uptight and obsessed with myself and therefore not able to receive his Blessing. I began to pray to be relieved of this self-consciousness and to become more able to receive what Adi Da had to Give.

Adi Da's persistent Personal Regard above all, but also the intensive process of finishing

the temple by the deadline, did eventually conspire to break down my defenses. Finally I found myself wholly relaxed in His Company and instead of being obsessed with my own mental states and agitated feelings I was able to be just present. I dropped into a deep meditative state and could feel Beloved Adi Da's Blessing Force like never before. It felt like a very intense, but blissful, pressure on my head that also pierced down to my heart, which felt like it was going to burst with the immense feelings going through it. I could finally see through unveiled eyes the Great Being that Adi Da truly is. This revelation is not really expressible in words, but is what our innermost being longs for and recognises with our feeling heart. It is really love in its purest form. Adi Da is pure love in human form. This incredible sight filled me with deep feelings of bliss and joy and caused me to sob tears of relief and gratitude. Now that I am back home again I feel that my practice has been greatly deepened by the Grace that was bestowed on me during this retreat.

Avatar Adi Da Samrai is not merely a great human being who speaks profound Truth — He is the Divine Reality Itself, Appearing in a human body in order to Offer His Revelation of Truth directly to all humankind. His Confession is one of Absolute No-Separation from all and All. It is His Inherent and Native State.

It is Adi Da's Confession that: There is no ultimate "difference" between you and the Divine. There is <u>only</u> the Divine.

Everything that exists is a "modification" of the One Divine Reality.

However, even though it may be true that there is only the Divine, this is not in fact our common daily experience, if indeed we ever glimpse the possibility of such a condition. There is something we are doing that is preventing this Realisation. Adi Da describes this "something" as the self-contraction, the <u>presumption</u> that we are separate.

Avatar Adi Da is humanly present in the world in order to reveal the Divine Condition of Love-Bliss, of Non-Separation, and to make it possible for people to realise that that Condition is our True and Very Nature.

This revelation is given through the relationship to Avatar Adi Da, the Non-Separate Divine Person. By becoming more and more turned to the Person and State of Avatar Adi Da, we are purified and grown beyond the presumption of separateness and into the Condition that is not separate from Adi Da or from anything else.

Within the context of this relationship, Adi Da has also had to address every area of our lives (from right diet and use of money, to preparing for death) to reveal the limitations we impose that prevent this native enjoyment of Non-Separation from the Divine. He also constantly addresses our urge to "seek" - based on the problem of our presumed separation and He points out that that search is always removing us from present time Communion with the Divine Reality Condition.

In this issue of Open Eyes we include some of the great proposals and confessions Avatar Adi Da makes about this Condition of Non-Separation. As always we invite you to consider for yourself the Truth Adi Da speaks. He has always called for us not to "believe" in Him and what He says, but to enter into feeling-consideration of what He says and Who He Is and discover the Truth of it for ourselves.

Not-Two Is Peace

Aberrations come when human life is detached from the Divine Source, and thus from the right context of relatedness in life. "No Source" means no relatedness, no cooperation, no guidance, no Source-Principle presented in life, no Divine Reality.

In the scale of human life, the Spiritual Master is necessary for human rightness and sanity and well-being and survival. The ego is dissociated from the True Source and from all relatedness. That is what I mean about egoity—it is separate and, therefore, separative. The right context of human life is not separateness. It is one with the Source, and does not live separativeness, but, rather, non-dissociative relatedness.

Therefore, the fundamental principles of life are Real God and True Guru. The Source-Position must be enacted if human beings are to be sane. That is the Way of the culture of Adidam. Rightly, the world altogether should be living in a manner that is connected to the Source.

This idealization of egoity, of independence, of separativeness and separateness, is literally destroying humankind, and the Earth itself. It is the expression of "Narcissus" all over the world. Everything is conflict and competition. Everyone is at war with everyone else. These days, wherever there is even very ordinary notions of difference, people make so much of it that it becomes the basis for potentially even global conflict.

This is insanity! It is inflaming the entire world.

The culture and Way of Adidam is the context of a structure of right life that is the proper order in time and space. The only way in which this madness of egoic separativeness is going to be stopped is through

the restoration of the culture of right life, connected to the Ultimate Reality-Source, engaged in the modes of relatedness that are expressed through cooperation, acceptance of guidance, accountability.

The culture and Way of Adidam as Communicated by Me is that context of structure of right life, and of the Divine and the Realizer as fundamentals: the Source, and the Manifestation of the Source that functions in the role of Guidance and Illumination. This is fundamental.

The culture that relates to the Source and to the Guide, the Realizer, is one necessarily about cooperation and relatedness, tolerance, and the overcoming of the dissociative, separate, and separative disposition.
